

Weekly Prayer Strategy

13 November – 19 November 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: The Fullness of the Spirit.

Prayer Point 1

Acts 6:3

"Therefore, brethren, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task.

- Pray that we may be a Church that is full of the Holy Spirit.
- Pray that we may serve the Lord in the fullness of the Holy Spirit in all that we do and not in the flesh.

Prayer Point 2

Acts 11:22-25

News of this reached the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. 23 When he arrived and saw what the grace of God had done, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts. 24 He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord. 25 Then Barnabas went to Tarsus to look for Saul,

- Ask the Holy Spirit to expand your capacity to contain Him.

Prayer Point 3

Acts 7:55

But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you anything that may be hindering His flow in your life.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit may show you the secrets to working in effective partnership with Him.

Prayer Point 4

John 3:5-8

Jesus answered “Truly, truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. Flesh is born of flesh, but spirit is born of the Spirit. Do not be amazed that I said, ‘You must be born again.’... The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.”

- **Pray that we may be a Church that leads the unsaved to be born of the spirit of Salvation.**

Prayer Point 5

Luke 24:49

..am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.”

Acts 1:4-5

And when they were gathered together, He commanded them: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift the Father promised, which you have heard Me discuss. 5For John baptized with water, but in a few days” you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 18:15-17

On their arrival, they prayed for them to receive the Holy Spirit. 16For the Holy Spirit had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had simply been baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus. 17Then Peter and John laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:12 - 14

The body is a unit, though it is comprised of many parts. And although its parts are many, they all form one body. So it is with Christ. 13For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free, and we were all given one Spirit to drink. 14For the body does not consist of one part, but of many....

- Pray that we may be a Church that fully embraces the baptism of the Holy Spirit and walks in all its benefits.
- Pray that we may teach the baptism of the Holy Spirit in our Church with clarity, fully addressing all misperceptions around it.

Prayer Point 6

Acts 4:7-8

They had Peter and John brought in and began to question them: “By what power or what name did you do this?” 8Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, “Rulers and elders of the people! 9If we are being examined today about a kind service to a man who was lame, to determine how he was healed,

- Pray that we may seek to minister under the tangible power of the Holy Spirit in every ministry in our Church, and when that happens, to never deny that the Holy Spirit is the power under which we minister.

Prayer Point 7

Acts 13:8-12

But Elymas the sorcerer (for that is what his name means) opposed them and tried to turn the proconsul from the faith. 9 Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked straight at Elymas and said, 10 “You are a child of the devil and an enemy of everything that is right! You are full of all kinds of deceit and trickery. Will you never stop perverting the right ways of the Lord? 11 Now the hand of the Lord is against you. You are going to be blind for a time, not even able to see the light of the sun.” Immediately mist and darkness came over him, and he groped about, seeking someone to lead him by the hand. 12 When the proconsul saw what had happened, he believed, for he was amazed at the teaching about the Lord.

- Pray for continued boldness to address all demonically inspired activity around us that seeks to distract us from advancing the Kingdom of God.
