

Weekly Prayer Strategy

20 November – 25 November 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: The Fullness of the Spirit Pt 2.

Prayer Point 1

Matthew 12:18

"Here is My servant, whom I have chosen, My beloved, in whom My soul delights. I will put My Spirit on Him, and He will proclaim justice to the nations.

- Pray that the anointing upon your life will always be directed toward fulfilling the purposes of the Kingdom of God.
- Pray that we may be a Church that desires increased levels of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
- Pray for supple hearts that will allow the Holy Spirit to have as much of us as He desires.

Prayer Point 2

Luke 4:18

"The Spirit of the Lord is on Me, because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim deliverance to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to release the oppressed,

- Pray that you may always operate and minister under the power of the Holy Spirit.

John 3:34 (NIV)

For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit.

- Pray that our greatest desire as a Church would be to boldly speak the Word of God in the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Point 3

Luke 1:15

"For he will be great in the sight of the Lord; and he will drink no wine or liquor, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit while yet in his mother's womb.

- Pray that we will be a Church that values behaviour and attitudes that are great in sight of the Lord.

Prayer Point 4

He gives you Power – Mt 12:28

He tells you of things to come – John 16:13

He gives you Boldness – Acts 4:31

He appoints ministries – Acts 20:28; Acts 13

He releases love – Romans 5:5

- Pray that we may be a Church completely yielded to the multi-faceted nature of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Point 5

Exodus 31:3

"I have filled him with the Spirit of God in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all kinds of craftsmanship,

- Pray that our lives will be enveloped by the Holy Spirit in wisdom, understanding, and knowledge.

Prayer Point 6

2 Cor 13:14

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

- Pray that we may be a Church that is intimate and in fellowship with the Holy Spirit.
- Invite the Holy Spirit to be your coach, senior partner and right hand aide.

Prayer Point 7

Ephesians 4:27 - 30

and do not give the devil a foothold. 28 Anyone who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with their own hands, that they may have something to share with those in need. 29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

- Pray that we may be a Church that does not grieve the Holy Spirit.
- Pray that the Lord will instil in us the character that contains the Spirit of God and that we walk in the fruit of the Spirit and reject the deeds of darkness.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you doors you have opened that have given the enemy legal access into your life that you need to close. Repent for opening those doors and close them.

Prayer Point 8

Acts 13:51-52

So they shook the dust off their feet in protest against them and went to Iconium. 52And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18b -19

Instead, be filled with the Spirit. 19Speak to one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your hearts to the Lord,...

- Pray that we would always be filled to capacity when it comes to the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Point 9

Acts 16:6

So the churches were strengthened in the faith and grew daily in numbers. 6After the Holy Spirit prevented them from speaking the word in the province of Asia, they travelled through the region of Phrygia and Galatia. 7And when they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not permit them....

- Pray for an openness to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Point 10

Luke 12:11-12

When you are brought before the synagogues, rulers, and authorities, do not worry about how to defend yourselves or what to say. 12For at that time the Holy Spirit will teach you what you should say.”

John 14:25-26

All this I have spoken to you while I am still with you. 26But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have told you.

John 16:14

However, when the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. For He will not speak on His own, but He will speak what He hears, and He will declare to you what is to come. 14He will glorify Me by taking from what is Mine and disclosing it to you. 15Everything that belongs to the Father is Mine. That is why I said that the Spirit will take from what is Mine and disclose it to you....

- Pray that we may be a Church that speaks Jesus' words with His heart, trusting in Him.
- Pray for an openness to the Holy Spirit to teach you what to say in all circumstances.

Prayer Point 11

Eph 5:17 – 19

Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. 18Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to reckless indiscretion.

- Pray that you will always be watchful in the spirit so that you are not under any unrighteous influences.

Prayer Point 12

Ps 22:3

But you are holy, you who inhabit the praises of Israel.

The Holy Spirit loves worship because He helps us to glorify Jesus in Spirit. One of His other roles is to help us to pray.

Romans 8:26

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

Acts 4:31

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

- Worship and pray all the time recognising your need for the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Point 13

1 Cor 12:4-6, 11

There are different kinds of gifts. But they are all given to believers by the same Spirit. 5 There are different ways to serve. But they all come from the same Lord. 6 There are different ways the Spirit works. But the same God is working in all these ways and in all people....11 All the gifts are produced by one and the same Spirit. He gives gifts to each person, just as he decides.

- Break all obstacles preventing you from being used in the gifts of the Spirit?
- Pray for a boldness to step out in the gifts of the Holy Spirit.
