

Weekly Prayer Strategy

23 October – 28 October 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: Mindset for Miracles Part 1.

Prayer Point 1

1 John 1:7

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

James 5:15-16

And the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick. The Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven. 16Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man has great power to prevail.

- Pray that we will be a community of believers that is healthily transparent with and accountable to each other exercising wisdom as far as possible.

Prayer Point 2

Romans 1:10-12

10in my prayers at all times, asking that now at last by God's will I may succeed in coming to you. 11For I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you, 12that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith.

- Pray that we may be a community of believers that mutually cares, loves and prays for each other.

Prayer Point 3

Col 3:16

Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

- Pray that we will be a community of believers that encourages each other to grow and mature in Christ and has each other's best interests at heart.

Prayer Point 4

Acts 12:5

So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him.

1 Timothy 5:3

Give proper recognition to those widows who are really in need.

- Pray that we will be a community that readily receives ministry from each other, genuinely caring for each other.

Prayer Point 5

Acts 6:7-8

7So the word of God continued to spread. The number of disciples in Jerusalem grew rapidly, and a great number of priests became obedient to the faith. 8Now Stephen, full of grace and power, was performing great wonders and signs among the people.

- Pray that we will be a community of believers that prays for the expansion of our family and engages in outreach activities to draw people to Christ.

Prayer Point 6

Matthew 19:26

With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.

Deuteronomy 10:21

He is the one you praise; he is your God, who performed for you those great and awesome wonders you saw with your own eyes

- Pray that we may be a Church that fully embraces the supernatural as governed by the Holy Spirit and rejects the philosophy of naturalism.

Prayer Point 7

Romans 8:10 -11

...10But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet the Spirit gives you life because of righteousness. 11And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who dwells within you.

Acts 3:4-8

4But Peter, along with John, fixed his gaze on him and said, “Look at us!” 5And he began to give them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. 6But Peter said, “I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene—walk!” 7And seizing him by the right hand, he raised him up; and immediately his feet and his ankles were strengthened. 8With a leap he stood upright and began to walk; and he entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God.

- Pray for a revelation of what you carry, to know that you are called to steward the miraculous dimension and that God has entrusted His power to you.
