

Weekly Prayer Strategy

30 October – 4 November 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: Mindset For Miracles.

Prayer Point 1

Matthew 11:12

And from the time John the Baptist began preaching until now, the Kingdom of Heaven has been forcefully advancing, and violent people are attacking it.

- Pray that we will be a Church that is alert and active, always ready to execute the purposes of God in our lives.

Prayer Point 2

2 Chronicles 16:9

For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him. In this you have done foolishly; therefore from now on you shall have wars.”

- Pray that our heart and minds would always be inclined to the obedience and service of Christ.

Prayer Point 3

1 Cor 2:10-12

But God has revealed it to us by the Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. 11For who among men knows the thoughts of man except his own spirit within him? So too, no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. 12We have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we may understand what God has freely given us.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would expand your inner man to contain the things of Heaven more.

Prayer Point 4

John 4:23 – 24

But a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth, for the Father is seeking such as these to worship Him. 24God is Spirit, and His worshipers must worship Him in spirit and in truth.”

- Pray that we may be a Church of those who worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth, desiring to truly connect with Him.

Prayer Point 5

Colossians 2:5

For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how disciplined you are and how firm your faith in Christ is.

2 Corinthians 12:3

I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of it I do not know, but God knows. 3And I know that this man — whether in the body or out of it I do not know, but God knows — 4was caught up into Paradise. The things he heard were too sacred for words, things that man is not permitted to tell.

- Pray that you will always carry a mind-set that is not limited by physical boundaries but taps into the Spiritual.

Prayer Point 6

Matthew 5:8

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

Romans 9:1-2

1I speak the truth in Christ; I am not lying, as confirmed by my conscience in the Holy Spirit. 2I have deep sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart.

Pray that you may never limit the power of your conscience and that you will always be prepared to embrace the burdens placed on your heart by God.
