

Weekly Prayer Strategy

4 June – 10 June 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: Unlocking Your Joy – Part II.

Prayer Point 1

Galatians 5:22

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness.

Rom 14:17

For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

- Pray that the fruit of the Spirit may manifest powerfully in your life. (Pray into each, one by one.)
- Pray that you would embrace the fullness of the kingdom of God in your life, excelling in righteousness, peace and joy.

Prayer Point 2

1 Chronicles 16:27

Splendour and majesty are before Him; strength and joy are in His dwelling place.

Psalms 45:7

You love righteousness and hate wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy.

- Pray that the strength and joy of the Lord may dwell in Go Church.
- Pray that our pastors and leaders in Go Church may minister in and be anointed with the oil of joy that comes from the Lord.

Prayer Point 3

Nehemiah 8:10

Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

- Pray that the joy of the Lord will be your strength in moments of weakness and despair.

Prayer Point 4

Esther 8:17

In every province and in every city to which the edict of the king came, there was joy and gladness among the Jews, with feasting and celebrating. And many people of other nationalities became Jews because fear of the Jews had seized them.

- Pray that the joy of the Lord will be so evident in Go Church that this joy would draw the unsaved to Christ Jesus.

Prayer Point 5

Isaiah 12:6

Praise the LORD in song, for He has done excellent things; Let this be known throughout the earth. Cry aloud and shout for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.

- Pray that the joy of the Lord may abound more and more in our services and Go groups such that the shout of the King will be heard in our midst.

Prayer Point 6

Psalm 27:6

Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at his sacred tent I will sacrifice with shouts of joy, I will sing and make music to the Lord.

Psalm 100:2

Worship the Lord with gladness, come before him with joyful songs.

- Pray that Go Church may be full of volunteers who serve God with joyful hearts knowing that their service is primarily unto God and not men.

Prayer Point 7

Isaiah 35:10

And those the LORD has rescued will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

- Commit yourself to never allow sorrow, tribulations and or any plan of the enemy of your life to rob you of your joy.

Prayer Point 8

2 John 1:12

I have much to write to you, but I do not want to use paper and ink. Instead, I hope to visit you and talk with you face to face, so that our joy may be complete.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to show you the relationships that you should invest in, in this season. Pray that the joy of the Lord may be unlocked and experienced through these relationships.

Prayer Point 9

John 15:11

I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

- Pray that one of your chief desires may be to abide in Christ so that your joy may be complete.

Prayer Point 10

- Pray that in your journey with Christ, one of your goals would be to look for opportunities to be joyful even in the midst of calamity.

Prayer Point 11

- Pray that the Holy Spirit will show you how to cultivate a lifestyle of gratitude so that your joy may be perpetual.

Prayer Point 12

Psalm 42:5

Why are you down cast Oh my soul? Put your hope in God.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would develop in you a stable emotional state so that the devil will never find a gap in your life to use to take away your joy.
