

Weekly Prayer Strategy

19 Nov – 24 Nov 2018

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled:

Overcoming Immaturity in Prayer Pt 3.

Prayer Point 1

1 John 5:14-15

¹⁴ "And this is the confidence that we have before Him: If we ask anything according to His will, He hears us". ¹⁵ And if we know that he hears us--whatever we ask-- we know that we have what we asked of him.

Jeremiah 29:11-13

¹¹ "For I know the plans that I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope. ¹² Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. ¹³ You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart".

Psalms 18:6

"In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears".

Luke 11:13

"If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

- Pray that you would have an accurate view of God the Father.
- Pray that God the Father would stimulate a new level of faith in you to believe that He hears your prayers.
- Pray that God would take you through a journey of learning and understanding the kind of prayers that He hears.

Prayer Point 2

Colossians 4:2

"Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful".

Romans 12:12

“Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, Faithful in prayer”

Ezekiel 22:30

"I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one. Maybe the undevoted person still hears what God is saying but doesn't fully pray it through"

- Pray that Jesus would always be first place in all you do.
- Pray for a heart that is wholly devoted to prayer, being watchful and thankful always.
- Ask God to show you what is on His heart and agenda and ask that He would give you a prayer burden for those things.

Prayer Point 3

Romans 8:26-27

²⁶ “In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know how we ought to pray, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans too deep for words. ²⁷ And He who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God”.

- Pray for a heart that partners with the Holy Spirit in prayer.
- Pray that God the Father would enable you to pray prayers that shift the spiritual and natural climate, prevailing/legislative prayers.
- Pray for wisdom to never short-circuit the power of the Holy Spirit in prayer.
- Pray for brokenness in you that allows the Holy Spirit to takeover everytime you pray.

Prayer Point 4

Jeremiah 33:3

“Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know”.
NLT- Ask me and I will tell you remarkable secrets you do not know about things to come.

Ephesians 3:20

“Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us” NLT - Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think. The key is imagine and listen in prayer. What do you expect from God. How big is He? In Hebrews ¹¹ it says He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

- Pray that we would be a Church that prays audacious prayers.
- Pray for a revelation of the unsearchable things of the Kingdom of God and begin to call forth those things in your prayers.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would enable you to feel the pleasure of God in your relationship with Him.
- Pray that God would expand your imagination, help you visualise His will so that you can believe Him for greater things.

Prayer Point 5

1 Peter 4:7

“The end of all things is near. Therefore be alert and of sober mind so that you may pray”.

- Pray for an alertness:
 - to watch the time bombs and enemy’s strategy in your life and uproot them immediately.
 - to watch for what God is doing and incline your prayers to what He is doing.

Prayer Point 6

Psalm 106:13-16

¹³ “But they soon forgot what he had done and did not wait for his plan to unfold. ¹⁴ In the desert they gave in to their craving; in the wilderness they put God to the test. ¹⁵ So he gave them what they asked for, but sent a wasting disease among them. ¹⁶ In the camp they grew envious of Moses and of Aaron, who was consecrated to the LORD”.

Psalm 27:13-14

¹³ “I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

¹⁴ Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD”

Psalm 37: 9

“For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the LORD will inherit the land”.

Daniel 10:12-14

¹² “Then he continued, “Do not be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day that you set your mind to gain understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to them. ¹³ But the prince of the Persian kingdom resisted me twenty-one days. Then Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, because I was detained there with the king of Persia. ¹⁴ Now I have come to explain to you what will happen to your people in the future, for the vision concerns a time yet to come.”

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would reinforce the virtue of patience in your life.
- Pray for wisdom to know when to persevere in prayer until breakthrough is achieved.
