

# Weekly Prayer Strategy

14 May – 18 May

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Michael Manyuni entitled:  
**The Sound of Resolution.**

## Prayer Point 1

- Pray that we would be a people always ready for the changing seasons of our lives and that we would respond to them in a Godly and mature manner.

## Prayer Point 2

- Pray that we would walk in faith when we respond to situations in our lives.

## Prayer Point 3

### 2 Kings 7:1

Then Elisha said, "Hear the word of the LORD. Thus says the LORD: 'Tomorrow about this time a seah of fine flour shall be sold for a shekel, and two seahs of barley for a shekel, at the gate of Samaria.

- Pray that we would always trust in the Word of God when facing the battles of life.

## Prayer Point 4

### 2 Kings 7:2

So an officer on whose hand the king leaned answered the man of God and said, "Look, if the LORD would make windows in heaven, could this thing be?" And he said, "In fact, you shall see it with your eyes, but you shall not eat of it."

- Pray that the Lord would increase your capacity to contain Him.

## Prayer Point 5

### Hebrews 4:2

For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would help us to be sensitive to the message of the Gospel so that it may profit us fully.

## **Prayer Point 6**

### **2 Kings 7:3-4**

<sup>3</sup> Now there were four leprous men at the entrance of the gate; and they said to one another, "Why are we sitting here until we die? <sup>4</sup> "If we say, 'We will enter the city,' the famine is in the city, and we shall die there. And if we sit here, we die also. Now therefore, come, let us surrender to the army of the Syrians. If they keep us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall only die."

- Pray that we would have the wisdom to know when to take the battle to the enemy's camp.

## **Prayer Point 7**

### **1 Timothy 6:12**

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

- Pray that God would give you the spirit of resilience to fight the good fight of faith.

## **Prayer Point 8**

### **2 Kings 7:5-9**

<sup>5</sup> And they rose at twilight to go to the camp of the Syrians; and when they had come to the outskirts of the Syrian camp, to their surprise no one was there. <sup>6</sup> For the Lord had caused the army of the Syrians to hear the noise of chariots and the noise of horses-the noise of a great army; so they said to one another, "Look, the king of Israel has hired against us the kings of the Hittites and the kings of the Egyptians to attack us!" <sup>7</sup> Therefore they arose and fled at twilight, and left the camp intact-their tents, their horses, and their donkeys-and they fled for their lives. <sup>8</sup> And when these lepers came to the outskirts of the camp, they went into one tent and ate and drank, and carried from it silver and gold and clothing, and went and hid them; then they came back and entered another tent, and carried some from there also, and went and hid it. <sup>9</sup> Then they said to one another, "We are not doing right. This day is a day of good news, and we remain silent. If we wait until morning light, some punishment will come upon us. Now therefore, come, let us go and tell the king's household."

- Pray that the Lord would grant us boldness to step out and walk the walk of faith even when circumstances do not look favourable.
