

Weekly Prayer Strategy

24 Mar – 30 Mar

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Stewart Bishop entitled:
Lighting Up Your Way.

Prayer Point 1

John 3:16

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 8:36

So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Ephesians 3:12

In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

- Pray for a revelation of the benefits of Salvation and that we would be a Church that fully embraces them.

Prayer Point 2

Galatians 5:1

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

- Pray that we would be watchful to never fall into the bondage of slavery again.

Prayer Point 3

Hosea 4:6

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge [of My law, where I reveal My will]. Because you [the priestly nation] have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you from being My priest.

Proverbs 5:23

He will die for lack of instruction (discipline). And in the greatness of his foolishness he will go astray and be lost.

- Pray that we would become disciplined in our pursuit of the Word so that we are not led astray by the enemy.

Prayer Point 4

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if anyone is in Christ [that is, grafted in, joined to Him by faith in Him as Savior], he is a new creature [reborn and renewed by the Holy Spirit]; the old things [the previous moral and spiritual condition] have passed away. Behold, new things have come [because spiritual awakening brings a new life].

- Pray that we would become supple to the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives so that we can truly live changed lifestyles.

Prayer Point 5

Romans 8:14

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would be our guide in all our endeavours.

Prayer Point 6

Psalms 119:130

The entrance of Your words gives light. It gives understanding to the simple.

- Invite the Holy Spirit to illuminate the word of God in your heart and to grant you wisdom to outwork it in your daily life.

Prayer Point 7

Psalms 119:133

Direct my steps by Your word and let no iniquity have dominion over me.

Psalms 119:105

Your word is a lamp to my feet. And a light to my path.

- Pray that your steps would be ordered by the Word of God and that iniquity would have no hold over you.

Prayer Point 8

2 Samuel 5:18-20

¹⁸ Now the Philistines had come and spread out in the Valley of Rephaim ¹⁹ So David inquired of the Lord, "Shall I go and attack the Philistines? Will you deliver them into my hands?" The Lord answered him, "Go, for I will surely deliver the Philistines into your hands." ²⁰ So David went to Baal Perazim, and there he defeated them. He said, "As waters break out, the Lord has broken out against my enemies before me." So that place was called Baal Perazim.

- Pray that we would fully understand that the word of God brings us victory in all of life.
- Pray that you would develop the habit of enquiring of the Lord on situations in your life, listening and carrying out action as instructed by God.

Prayer Point 9

Deuteronomy 6:6-8

⁶ These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be [written] on your heart and mind.

⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your ^[a]children [impressing God's precepts on their minds and penetrating their hearts with His truths] and shall speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road and when you lie down and when you get up. ⁸ And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand (forearm), and they shall be used as bands (frontals, frontlets) on your forehead.

- Pray that we would be diligent to teach the word of God to our children and future generations.
