

Weekly Prayer Strategy

3 June – 8 June

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Stewart Bishop entitled:
The Greatness of Jesus Christ.

Prayer Point 1

Hebrews 1:1-4

¹ In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, ² but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. ³ The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. ⁴ So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.

Hebrews 2:8

You have put all things in subjection under his feet. For in subjecting all things to him, He left nothing that is not subject to him...

John 1:3

All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

Colossians 1:16

For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

- Pray that just as Christ has put everything in subjection under His feet that we too would subject the enemy under our feet in our situations.

Prayer Point 2

Habbakuk – I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled. Habakkuk 3:16

Ezekiel: This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord. When I saw it, I fell facedown Ezekiel 1:27

Job: My ears had heard of you, but now my eyes have seen you, Therefore I despise myself, and repent in dust and ashes. Job 42:5-6

Daniel: I, Daniel, was the only one who saw the vision; the men with me did not see it, but such terror overwhelmed them that they fled and hid themselves. So I was left alone, gazing at this great vision; I had no strength left, my face turned deathly pale and I was helpless Daniel 10:7-8, 9:20

John: When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. Revelation 1:17

Philippians 3:21

who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

2 Thessalonians 2:8

And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus will overthrow with the breath of his mouth and destroy by the splendor of his coming.

2 Corinthians 4:4

in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would give us a revelation of the glory of Christ and that our lives would reflect that glory.

Prayer Point 3

HE IS THE HEIR OF ALL THINGS: Jesus is the unique Son of the living God. He is the sovereign Lord of the universe. The world belongs to Jesus Christ. He is the rightful heir of all things and we are co-heirs with Jesus.

HE IS THE CREATOR OF ALL THINGS: Jesus did not have His beginning at Bethlehem. He was present in the creation of the world. In fact He is the Creator. The heavens themselves declare the glory of our Lord.

HE UPHOLDS ALL THINGS: That is, He holds the universe together by the Word of His power. It is in Jesus that we live and move and have our being.

- Pray that we would be strengthened in the knowledge that we are co-heirs with Christ and that in him we live, move and have our being.

Prayer Point 4

John 10:30 Amplified Bible (AMP)

I and the Father are One [in essence and nature].”

John 14:11 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me.

- Pray that we would desire greater intimacy with God the Father in our daily relationship with Him.

Prayer Point 5

- Pray that we would have a revelation of the attributes of Christ and that we would desire more and more to be like Him.
