

# Weekly Prayer Strategy

6 May – 11 May

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled:

## Glorifying God Pt 3.

### Prayer Point 1 - Thanksgiving is a key in glorifying the Lord

#### Ps 69:30

I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving.

- Pray that our lives may be characterised by glorifying God with thanksgiving in all circumstances.

### Prayer Point 2 - Sin takes away from the glory of God being reflected in our lives

#### Rom 3:23

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

- Repent of all sin in your life so that there may be no hindrances to glorifying God.

### Prayer Point 3 - God's Glory is exclusively for Him.

#### Ps 115:1

Not to us, Lord, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness.

#### Ps 86:8-10

<sup>8</sup> Among the gods there is none like you, Lord; no deeds can compare with yours. <sup>9</sup> All the nations you have made will come and worship before you, Lord; they will bring glory to your name. <sup>10</sup> For you are great and do marvellous deeds you alone are God.

#### John 3:30

He must become greater; I must become less

- Pray that we would receive the revelation that God's Glory cannot be shared.
- Pray that in all we do, we would exalt the Lord and seek to reflect His glory in all things.

#### **Prayer Point 4 - God is glorified when His acts are revealed.**

##### **Rev 15:4**

Who will not fear you, Lord, and bring glory to your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed.”

- Pray that our worship would be a response to the full revelation that we have His glory.
- Pray that we would be a Church that never ceases to share testimonies and talk about the deeds of God to each other.

#### **Prayer Point 5 - God is glorified when we surrender or die**

##### **John 13:31-32**

<sup>31</sup> When he was gone, Jesus said, “Now the Son of Man is glorified and God is glorified in him.

<sup>32</sup> If God is glorified in him, God will glorify the Son in himself, and will glorify him at once.

##### **John 21:18-19**

<sup>18</sup> Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go.” <sup>19</sup> Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, “Follow me!

##### **Luke 22:42**

Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.”

- Pray that we may be those who are continually yielded to God in all manner, always praying the prayer of relinquishment unto Jesus.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to show you what you still need to die to or lay down before God. Pray that you would yield yourself fully to Him in those things.

#### **Prayer Point 6 - God is glorified when we are fruitful**

##### **John 15:8**

This is to my Father’s glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

- Pray that you may become fully grafted into the vine that you may bear much fruit in Him so that God is glorified.

#### **Prayer Point 7 - God is glorified when we complete our assignment**

##### **John 17:4**

I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do.

## **2 Thess 1:11-12**

<sup>11</sup> With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. <sup>12</sup> We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

- Pray that we would be a Church that prioritises God's assignments in everything we do.

## **Prayer Point 8 - We are called to glorify God with our bodies**

### **1 Cor 6:19 - 20**

<sup>19</sup> Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; <sup>20</sup> you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies.

- Pray that we would be those who Glorify God in our bodies and consecrate them to Him.

## **Prayer Point 9 - We glorify Him when we receive a stewardship mindset**

### **Romans 8:9**

You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ.

- Pray for a revelation that you belong to Jesus and that you were bought for a price.
