

Weekly Prayer Strategy

2 July – 7 July 2018

This week's prayer strategy is based on the Testimonies given in Church on 1 July 2018.

Prayer Point 1

- Pray that you would not fear to step out and execute what God has called you to.

Prayer Point 2

2 Timothy 2: 20-21

But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. ²¹ Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

- Pray that you will always be prepared to be a vessel for God's honour.

Prayer Point 3

"You will never possess what you are unwilling to pursue" - Mike Murdoch.

- What are the things that you have stopped pursuing and need to pick up in prayer?
- Pray that God would help you believe again so that you can tenaciously pursue those things again.

Prayer Point 4

Psalm 75:6-7

For exaltation comes neither from the east, nor from the west nor from the south. But God is the Judge: He puts down one, and exalts another.

- Pray that you would be one that recognises that promotion comes above and not man.
- If you are trusting God for promotion, pray that He would help you yield to His ways, timing and desires.

Prayer Point 5

1 Samuel 15:22

²² So Samuel said: “Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you areas where you may not have stood in obedience before God. Repent as the Spirit leads.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide you as you learn true and lasting obedience in God and in His Word.

Prayer Point 6

Mark 9:23

²³ Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, all things *are* possible to him who believes.”

- Call out to God to breakthrough on your behalf in every seemingly impossible situation in your life.
- Pray that you would have the audacity to do great exploits for God.

Daniel 11: 32

“...but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits”.

Prayer Point 7

2 Chronicles 20: 20

²⁰ So they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, “Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.”

- Pray for a willingness to allow God to speak to you, to listen to Him and apply what He tells you.

Prayer Point 8

“Happiness begins between your ears. Your mind is the drawing room for your circumstances” (Mike Murdock).

Isaiah 53:1

Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

- Pray for a heart that believes God’s report and not man’s.
- Pray that God’s word would be your reality.

Prayer Point 9

1 Corinthians 10:13-14

¹³No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to ¹⁴bear it.

1 Corinthians 6:12

¹²All things are lawful for me, but all things are not ¹³helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of ¹⁴any.

- If you are struggling with an addiction or know someone who is, bring the situation before God. Approach your pastors or seek professional help if need be.
- Pray and break off that habit. Ensure that you are surrounded by people with whom you can be accountable in this area.

Prayer Point 10

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal to you any sin or weight that you may be carrying that may deter you from achieving the call of God.

Prayer Point 11

Exodus 23:8

And you shall take no bribe, for a bribe blinds the discerning and perverts the words of the righteous.

- Pray for an integrous heart, one that is not attracted to bribery.

Prayer Point 12

1 Corinthians 9:24

²⁴ Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may ^[a]obtain *it*.

Discipline is the bridge between goals and accomplishment.

Setting goals is the first step in turning the invisible into the visible.

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would instil in you the spirit of discipline to accomplish what you set out do.
