

## **Weekly Prayer Strategy**

**23 July – 28 July 2018**

**This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: Cultural Agility Pt 3.**

### **Prayer Point 7 – Decision Making**

**Romans 1:13-15**

**I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, how often I planned to come to you (but have been prevented from visiting until now), in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles. 14I am obligated both to Greeks and non-Greeks, both to the wise and the foolish. 15That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are in Rome.**

- Pray that you would never lose focus of your mission but would always be determined to spread the Gospel against all hindrances.

**1 Corinthians 9:20**

**To the Jews I became like a Jew, to win the Jews. To those under the law I became like one under the law (though I myself am not under the law), so as to win those under the law.**

**Philippians 1:15-18**

**It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill. 16 The latter do so out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. 17 The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. 18 But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice.**

- Pray that you would not be judgemental when relating to different cultures but would have the wisdom to connect with them in such a manner that they become receptive to the Gospel.

## **1 Samuel 16:7**

**But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."**

- Pray for wisdom to know when to make a decision based on what your heart is telling you.

## **1 Timothy 3:1-12**

**Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task. 2 Now the overseer is to be above reproach, faithful to his wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. 4 He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him, and he must do so in a manner worthy of full[a] respect. 5 (If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) 6 He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. 7 He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap. 8 In the same way, deacons[b] are to be worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. 9 They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. 10 They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons. 11 In the same way, the women[c] are to be worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything. 12 A deacon must be faithful to his wife and must manage his children and his household well. 13 Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus.**

- Pray that would have the skill to balance the head and heart in decision – making.

## **John 17:19-20**

**For them I sanctify Myself, so that they too may be sanctified by the truth. 20I am not asking on behalf of them alone, but also on behalf of those who will believe in Me through their message.**

### **Exodus 3:15**

**God, furthermore, said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you ' This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name to all generations.**

### **2 Timothy 2:2**

**The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.**

- Pray that we would be a Church that has a multi-generational vision in our praying and kingdom strategies.
- Pray for a revelation of what God has put in you for other generations and how to release it.
- Pray for wisdom, to know how to effectively pass on the teaching of Christ Jesus to the next generation.
