

Weekly Prayer Strategy

5 November – 11 November 2017

This week's prayer strategy is based on the sermon by Paul Nyamuda entitled: Activating Miracles.

Prayer Point 1

James 1:22

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

Hebrews 5:14

But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

- Repent for every unbelief you have that hinders you from believing in miracles.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will help you to shift from theoretical knowledge that miracles can be reality to a practical demonstration of the power of God in your life as you step out to embrace and trust Him for miracles.

Prayer Point 2

1 John 2:27

As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him.

- Pray that you will have a teachable heart, allowing the Holy Spirit to guide and teach you as your revelation in the supernatural things of God grows.
- Pray that we will be a Church that remains fully grafted in Christ avoiding works of the flesh.
- Pray that we may be a Church that guards the anointing of God bestowed upon us so that we may never miss what God is doing.

Prayer Point 3

1 John 3:8

The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

- Pray that we may be a fearless Church that consistently exercises its authority over the devil in every dimension of our lives.

Prayer Point 4

Acts 10:38

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

- Pray that everyone in our Church may be fully convinced that miracles are central to the ministry of Jesus Christ.
- Pray that an atmosphere of miracles may become the norm in our services, Go groups and homes.

Prayer Point 5

1 Corinthians 2:12-14

What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us.¹³ This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words.^[a] ¹⁴ The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

Matthew 10:8

Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy,[a] drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give.

- Pray that we may always jealously guard what God has given us. That we may never give room to the enemy to deceive or steal from us what is rightfully ours.

Prayer Point 6

Luke 8:40 – 46

Now when Jesus returned, a crowd welcomed him, for they were all expecting him. 41 Then a man named Jairus, a synagogue leader, came and fell at Jesus' feet, pleading with him to come to his house 42 because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying. As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him. 43 And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years,[a] but no one could heal her. 44 She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped. 45 "Who touched me?" Jesus asked. When they all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you."46 But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me."

- Pray for the humility to recognise that it is Jesus who performs miracles through us and not something we conjure with our human power.
- Pray for the audacity to fight for your miracle against all the odds in the natural.
- Pray that that Holy Spirit will reveal to you that you are a Glory dispenser.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will show you what those things that short circuit the anointing in your life.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will show you what those things that release the power of God in your life.

Prayer Point 7

Luke 8:40 – 48

47 Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed. 48 Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace."

Pray that knowledge of the will of God for your life will always drive you to pursue a lifestyle miracles.

Prayer Point 8

Luke 8:49

49 While Jesus was still speaking, someone came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. “Your daughter is dead,” he said. “Don’t bother the teacher anymore.”

- Pray that your eyes will be consistently focused on God until your miracle takes place, never being deterred by “human timings”.

Prayer Point 9

Luke 8:51-52

51 When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except Peter, John and James, and the child’s father and mother. 52 Meanwhile, all the people were wailing and mourning for her. “Stop wailing,” Jesus said. “She is not dead but asleep.”

- Pray for wisdom to know which voices to shun and which to welcome as you pursue your miracle.

Prayer Point 10

Luke 8:53-56

53 They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But he took her by the hand and said, “My child, get up!” 55 Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat. 56 Her parents were astonished, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened.

- Pray that you will never be distracted by “laughs” that are determined to stop your miracles.
- Pray that you will always be aware of potential “miracle stoppers” that the devil might want to bring in your life.
